 - Reach out to Soror Johnson to find out if we can purchase a house at this time.

Emergency Response Taskforce- Soror Johnson

- "Sisters, Service, and Safety"
- Soror Gibson attended a webinar on Delta Emergency Response. Beginning with the 2021-2022 sorority year, Emergency Response will be a chapter compliance item, with documentation to be completed in the red zone.
- Each chapter must have an Emergency Response chairperson at minimum, and ideally an ERT committee. Each chapter must submit a yearly emergency response plan, including providing Sorors with red envelopes with personal demographic/medical information.
- Sorors should have a red envelope in each of these places: their vehicles, at work, and when they go out in the community/attend events.
- There should be a communication plan and a "drill" at least twice per year for Sorors to be prepared to respond to an emergency, evacuation, natural or man-made disaster, or other event. Each chapter should submit documentation and pictures of their training.
- During and after an emergency, evacuation, a natural or man-made disaster or an event, a situation report (new) will need to be submitted to the state ERT

coordinator who will then forward the information to the regional ERT coordinator, who will then forward the information to the national ERT coordinator. The SITREP will describe the situation and the post incident. This report will generate information on whether Sorors are accounted for, and will determine whether a rescue phase and/or a recovery phase is necessary.

- During an emergency, a natural or man-made disaster or an event, chapters are to activate their chapter phone list.
 - ERT
 - Emergency Plan for your family
 - Red Envelope in your purse and care
 - Talk & tell a Soror (or family member/friend) the time and location of where you're going to be.
 - Helpful websites/Resources

 - sba.gov
 - State & Local Agencies
 - DREF (has a disaster assistance application)
